

Juniper currently has two treehouses, with six more planned for the future. Each treehouse has a king bed and sleeps two guests.





# Pricing

A private buyout gives you exclusive access to our 10-acre property. Unlike a standard vacation rental, our fully-staffed boutique lodge offers curated experiences and personalized service, making it ideal for retreats, celebrations, wedding weekends and group getaways. A two-night minimum stay is required for full lodge buyouts.

## **PEAK (MAY - OCTOBER)**

Includes all five lodge rooms and both treehouses, accommodating a total of 14 overnight guests.





# Food & Beverage

## ONSITE DINING OPTIONS

- **Breakfast & Coffee:** Choose from a continental spread with a coffee bar or premade in-room options like yogurt or overnight oats starting at \$20 per person. Complimentary coffee and tea is included.
- **Lunch:** Enjoy boxed lunches starting at \$35 per person or catered service from a local provider.
- **Dinner:** Elevate your experience with a private chef's dinner, tailored to your group, or a catered service from a local provider.

## BEVERAGES & BAR SERVICE

- **Honor Bar:** Always stocked with beer, wine, and spirits, with charges covered by the host or individual guests via credit card. As a liquor licensed venue, Juniper is a no-BYOB venue.
- **Bartending Services:** Available as an add-on for custom cocktails or full bar service at any time during your stay. Bartending is \$55 per hour.
- **Bar Packages:** Ask for our bar package menu, which can be customized based on your needs if bartending service is added.

# Frequently Asked Questions

## **1. Do you have a kitchen? Can I prepare food onsite?**

We do not have a kitchen for guest use. Our Bar & Lounge has a wet bar area with an Honor Bar, plates and cutlery, ice machine, toaster, and microwave. We do not allow hot food preparation onsite (e.g. grilling, crockpot, etc.). We recommend having meals catered or dining out at a local restaurant - we have a lot of great options within 5 - 15 minutes of Juniper!

## **2. Do you have a refrigerator?**

There are mini fridges in all guest rooms except for the Aspen Room. There is also a refrigerator in the Bar & Lounge area that is pre-stocked with beverages for purchase.

## **3. Can I bring my own alcohol?**

As Juniper is a liquor licensed venue, we do not allow guests to consume their own alcohol in any common areas onsite during private buyouts. All alcohol must be purchased through Juniper. We have a small Honor Bar onsite stocked with wine, beer, and spirits for purchase.

## **4. How does the Honor Bar work?**

The Honor Bar is a self-serve bar stocked with soda, juice, mixers, beer, full bottles of wine, and spirits. As a host, you can choose to cover the Honor Bar tab, or allow guests to pay for their own drinks by putting a credit card on file upon check in. We can work with you to customize the bar based on your guests' beverage preferences.

## **5. Can I invite non-overnight guests over during a private lodge buyout?**

Yes. While we can usually accommodate a few additional guests during specified times with no additional fees, event venue fees may be applicable with larger groups or for events that may require staff. All non-overnight guests must depart by 10:30 p.m.

# Frequently Asked Questions

## **6. Is onsite parking available?**

Yes, Juniper has a free parking lot. We can accommodate up to 10 cars onsite.

## **7. Are ride share services available to or from Juniper?**

Uber and Lyft drivers are active in our area during the day and usually take less than 30 minutes to arrive on the property. Later in the evening and early in the morning, ride share services can be harder to find. We recommend you have a vehicle onsite.

## **8. Are children allowed?**

While Juniper is typically an adults-only lodge, we do allow children onsite for private lodge buyouts.

## **9. How is Juniper different from a vacation rental?**

Unlike Airbnb or VRBO, we provide a fully staffed experience with onsite hosts available throughout your stay. Daily housekeeping keeps common areas refreshed, with room touch-ups available upon request. While we don't have a shared kitchen, we offer curated onsite dining options, private chef experiences, and local catering recommendations. Juniper combines the privacy of a full buyout with the elevated service of a boutique hotel.

## **10. Can I hold a small wedding ceremony during my private buyout?**

# Frequently Asked Questions

## **11. Is Juniper pet friendly?**

Yes, we allow well-behaved dogs in our Boxelder and Evergreen Rooms with a \$35 pet fee per dog per stay.

## **12. What is your cancellation policy for private buyouts?**

Private lodge buyout payments are non-refundable, but we do allow for one reschedule of the buyout pending availability within 12 months of your original date.

## **13. Is Juniper accessible?**

While Juniper is not ADA compliant, the Mountain View Deck, and Boxelder and Evergreen Rooms can be accessed without the use of stairs.

## **14. Do you have recommendations for additional nearby lodging?**

We recommend Comfort Suites (3 minute drive), Origin Red Rocks (14 minute drive), The Eddy Hotel (20 minute drive), The Dove Inn (20 minute drive), and Highland Haven (17 minutes) for additional lodging.

## **15. What time is check in/check out?**

Check in is at 3 p.m. and check out is at 11 a.m.
